Register

YOU may register to vote if:

- you are a United States citizen.
- you are at least 18 by election day.
- you are an Ohio resident at least 30 days before election day.
- you are not in jail or prison for a felony.
- a court has not ruled that you can not vote.

Get a Voter Registration Form:

- from Ohio Citizen Advocates.
- at a library.
- at a high school or vocational school.
- at a Bureau of Motor Vehicles office.
- at your county board of elections.
- at the Dept. of Job and Family Services.
- at the WIC office.

Someone at these places can take your form.

YOU will need identification:

- valid Ohio driver's license or
- the last 4 digits of your social security number
- or write "none" on line 10.

YOU must know:

- your address with zip code.
- the county you live in.
- your birthday.

Use blue or black ink.

Ask for help if you want help.

Deadline to register is October 6, 2008

Take YOUR identification:

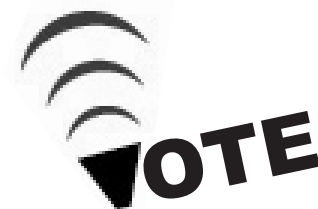
- valid Ohio driver's license or
